Dear Families,

I hope you are all making wonderful summer, family memories! We are having a great time with the kids in our summer day program at the Trower Center and school locations. Please continue to read if you are interested in school year registration.

Registration for after school programming is open now. We currently have staffing to open the Trower Center, Fairmont, Hemlock, Markham and Padan sites. Our intent is to bring the middle school and teen program back online or offer space for them at the Trower Center, however, we are experiencing issues with finding quality candidates to hire. Our goal is to get fully staffed to reopen our 9 locations including Jepson, Vaca Pena and the teen program.

Because staffing is an issue, we are not able to offer transportation support yet. If your child does not attend an ASES elementary site, they will be assigned to attend Trower and you will need to come up with a transportation solution. We appreciate your patience as we move to resume full operations as quickly as possible.

In the meantime, registration forms are available at Fairmont, Hemlock, Markham and Padan elementary, or at the Trower Center, 100 Holly Lane. Please return completed application forms to the Trower Center. It is a first come, first serve basis at this point and each site will allow 30 students into the program based on staffing and CDC restrictions. We will contact you regarding your child's membership application status.

Current families have been great with the mask mandates. All staff and youth are still required to wear masks indoors but may remove them when we're outside. Thank you for understanding that we are a workplace and therefore, need to follow CalOSHA guidelines in addition to CA Dept of Public Health and the CDC. We will continue to have temperature upon arrival and departure of the children and ask that you continue to notify us if your child has been exposed.

Our final day of summer and full day operations is Friday, August 6. Never before in our history have we offered 73 continuous weeks of full day operations for the children and I am especially proud of how our staff team handled this past year. We look forward to welcoming your child back on the first day of school, August 12. Feel free to call if you have any questions: 707-999-5034
